



Enrolment share by sector 1970 to 2010




Enrolment change by sector NSW 1985 – 2010








Schools recurrent funding by sector 2008-09



Government and independent sectors recurrent income by source 2009












Sliding scale of funding entitlement per student according to SES score (2010 final amounts)




Independent schools by SES score 2009





Non-systemic school funding sources and non-systemic enrolments by school SES score 2006


